10 Days Singapore / Bali / Malaysia Package

Day 1, Arrive in Singapore (D)

Arrive at The Changi International Airport, Singapore. You will be received by our local tour guide and transferred to a hotel for check-in (Depends on flight schedule, the check-in time is 2 pm daily). Take rest until 5:30pm. Then, gather in the hotel lobby for transfer to a restaurant to have dinner. After dinner, visit the Night Safari which is the world's first zoo for nocturnal animals. It is located outside the urban area, covering 40 hectares of secondary rainforest in Singapore. You may choose to walk or ride in a tram. There are 130 kinds of animals, out of which 35% are endangered species. Under the special lighting, it looks like being in a moon light. You will be able to observe the whereabouts of these nocturnal animals in a wide natural habitat, which sure is adventurous. There are also Animal shows and Fire shows for your entertainment.



Day 2, Singapore (B/L/D)

After the breakfast in hotel, get ready at the hotel lobby by 9 am. Our first visit will be **The Singapore Botanical Garden**, which was built in the year 1859 and covers an area of 52 hectares. The most famous is the **National Orchid Garden** which was built in 1995 and covers an area of 3 hectares. There are more than 400 purebred and 2000 breeds of precious orchids with a total number more than 60,000.

The next visit is to the city area, passing by the **High Court of Singapore, Merlion Park, the People Monument**, etc. Next is a boat ride in **Singapore River**. The whole journey takes about 30 minutes. From the boat, one can see the Clifford Pier, Esplanade, Parliament House etc, the whole unique scenery of Singapore.



After lunch, do shopping in the largest duty free shop of Southeast Asia, **DFS Singapore**.

Followed by a trip to Little India, Singapore's Indian district where you can buy different kinds of Indian artifacts, snacks, spices and a variety of things neither seen nor heard of.

Then a visit to **China Town (Niu Che Shui or Kreta Ayer means "bull-cart water")**, where in the past, every household had to pull bullock cart water from Ann Siang Hill.

Last visit for the day is Mount Faber, which is located to the south of Singapore. It is 115 meters above the sea level. It is the second highest point in Singapore next to Bukit

Timah Hill. It is near to the city area, facing the Singapore's harbor. It has sweeping views of the surrounding area and at night the housing blocks light up the night sky. From the view point, you can easily see the skyscrapers of the central business district area and even the islands of Indonesia.

Day 3, Singapore (B/L/D)

At 9am, gather at hotel lobby. Our guide will take you to the **Sky Park**, which is located at the top floor of **Marina Bay Sands Hotel**. It's a boat shaped



structure standing on the top of three unique curved towers (hotel's buildings). It stretches longer than the Eiffel tower when laid down, which is also 4.5 times the size of A380 Jumbo Jets, with an impressive 12,400 square meters of area, the Sands Sky Park can host up to 3900 people. The gravity-defying cantilever is one of the largest of its kind in the





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world. From this privileged observation deck, hundreds of visitors at a time can feast their eyes on the unforgettable panorama view of Singapore.

The next visit station is **Istana Kampong Glam**, the name derived from the Glam tree which grew in the area. This place has strong ties to the Singapore ethnic-Malay and Muslim community. On Islamic Prophet Mohammed's Birthday, Muslims from all over the island gather here for celebration.

After lunch, a visit to the Sentosa Island, Singapore's most famous tourist spot. First, visit the **Image of Singapore**, a place which will bring the culture and heritage of Singapore life right in front of your eyes by vivid real size figures, patronymics and other special effects. We will have our dinner at a restaurant in this island. After dinner, Songs of the sea show, which will be another amazing enjoyment. This gives you an astounding multi-sensory experience with a combination of water and laser effect. With a world class water jet, enchanting laser effects, fascinating fireworks, and surrounding music effects, the show will take you into an old fairytale where you feel yourself a part of the legend.



Day 4, Singapore - Bali (B/L/D)

We will leave to **Bali** this day. Gather at hotel lobby after lunch. Then, transfer to airport. Check in the flight to Bali. It is Indonesia's famous tourist spot, located at east side of Java islands, an island chain with an area of about more than 5560 square kilometers. Upon arrival, our local tour guide will receive you and help you proceed to the hotel for check in. Have dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 5, Bali (B/L/D)

After breakfast, go to **Uluwatu**, the most famous cliffs situated at the southern end of Bali. Followed by Garuda Vishnu Kencana, a statue made from more than 4000 tons of



copper and brass. The statue pictures Lord Vishnu as the source of wisdom, riding on the back of a mythical bird Garuda as a manifestation of conscience towards Amerta, a perennial goodness.



After lunch, visit **Celuk Village**, a famous village in Bali. This is a tourist spot because the local residents are very proactive and have innovation to the gold and silver crafting. Last for the day; visit **Pura Tirta Empul** a thousand year old temple, whose sacred spring is said to have been created by Indra and to have curative properties. The tradition continues almost unchanged at the temple today.

Day 6, Bali (B/L/D)



After breakfast, we will go to one of the largest temples in Bali, **Taman Ayun Temple**. It is a Royal Temple of Mengwi Empire and is located in Mengwi Village.



After lunch, we will see the monkey group in Bali. Then we will visit the most famous temple, Tanah Lot. The temple is



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built on rocks with 3 acre area and is reachable in a few minute by walk as it is just 20 meters from the coast.

Day 7, Bali – Kuala Lumpur - Genting (B/L/D)

After breakfast, go to airport and board the flight to Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. Upon arrival, our local guide will receive you and will transfer you to **Genting Highland**. Free up yourself until dinner time. Our dinner is in one of the local restaurant. After dinner, the guide will take you to the Casino.

Day 8, Genting - Kuala Lumpur (B/L/D)



We will take the cable car down the highland and will transfer to Kuala Lumpur after having our breakfast in hotel. We will visit the National Monument, National Mosque, the Royal Palace location, the High Court, the Petronas Twin Tower and Tin processing plant.

Day 9, Kuala Lumpur – Malacca (B/L/D)



After breakfast, we will go to Putrajaya. It is a planned city, located 25km south of Kuala Lumpur. It serves as the federal administrative centre of Malaysia. The whole area includes Wetlands, the Prime Minister's Office, Water Mosque, Prince Edward Bridge, the Prime Minister's



official Residence, Dammam Botanical Garden, and Prince Conference Center. After lunch we will proceed to ancient city – Malacca.

Day 10, Malacca - Departure (B/L)

Have breakfast at the hotel. Then, visit **Bukit China, Cheng Hoon Teng Temple, Dutch Square, Porta De Santiago** and local product shop.

After having lunch, transfer to airport to board your return flight.
