8 Days Egypt Desert Safari Tour

Day 1, Arrival Cairo

Upon arrival Cairo finalize passport through immigration and customs procedures, then transfer to your hotel.

Day 2, Cairo (B/L)

After breakfast at hotel, you will start your tour with **Egyptian Museum**, is home to an extensive collection of ancient Egyptian. It has



120,000 items, with a representative amount on display, the remainder in storerooms.

Lunch at a local restaurant during the tour.

After lunch proceed to visit

Pyramid, The **Egyptian pyramids** are ancient pyramid-shaped masonry structures located in Egypt. There are 138 pyramids discovered in Egypt as of 2008. Most were built as tombs for the country's Pharaohs and their consorts during the Old and Middle Kingdom periods. Next to **the Sphinx**, The Great Sphinx of Giza, commonly referred to as the Sphinx, is a limestone statue of a reclining or couchant sphinx that stands on the Giza Plateau on the west bank of the Nile in Giza, Egypt. After the tour return to your hotel for over nights.





Day 3, Baharia Oasia (B/L/D)

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to Bahariya Oasia by private via



the desert road. Upon arrival, check in hotel. Then visit the temple of Ain Mufella, Roman Water Source, Tomb of Bannantiu, the temple of Alexandert the great, Bahariya Museum & the Golden Mummies and the English houses. Lunch

& transfer back to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Tomb of Bannantiu. The tomb is situated within the city of Bawiti in <u>Bahariya Oasis</u>, it was discovered after the disclosure of many stone coffins beside it, which contains found decomposing mummies as well as artifacts and statues known as (Al Oshabty). The tomb's name can be







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pronounced as "Banati" or "Banentinom" or "Bnewta" as it is written in different ways in the texts of the cemetery.


Day 4, Bahariya Oasia – White Deset (B/L/D)

Moring, departure by 4x4 jeep to the white desert. Visit the **black deset.** It is closer to Bahariya, 50km to the South of Bawiti. The mountains



have eroded to coat the desert with a layer of black powder and rocks giving it its name. Next to **Dune area** then climb 50 meter dude.

Lunch at E1 Heiz Oasis. On the





desert to explore the formations & wind carved sculptors.

Evening, BBQ dinner and sleep in tents under the stars at the white desert. Overnight camping at the White Desert



Day 5, Bahariya Oasia – Alexandria (B)

After breakfast, leave the Oasis behind and drive north to **Alexandria**, for the next 2 night stay at your selected hotel. Rest of the day is at leisure.

Alexandria is the second largest city and the second largest metropolitan area in Egypt after Greater Cairo by size and population, extending about 32 km along the coast of the Mediterranean Sea in the north central part of the country.



Day 6, Alexandria (B/L)

Breakfast & start your visite with the **Greece-Roman Museum**, was created in 1892. It was first built in an five-room apartment. The museum



has been closed for renovations since 2008. As of January 2013, the building was still surrounded by scaffolding. Next to **National Museum.** It was inaugurated the 31 December 2003 by Hosni Mubarak and it's located in a restored Italian style palace in Tariq Al-Horreya

Street. The building used to be home to the United States consulate. After lunch continue to visit **Pompey's Pillar & Roman Amphitheater**, **the Catacomb's** & Qait Bay Citade.Lunch at a local restaurant during the tour.







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Day 7, Alexandria - Cairo (B)

After breakfast at hotel, visit to the **Alexandria Library**, was one of the largest



and most significant libraries of the ancient world. It was dedicated to the Muses, the nine goddesses of the arts. Next to **Montazah Palace Gardens**, is a palace and extensive gardens in the Montaza district of Alexandria, Egypt. It



was built on a low plateau east of central Alexandria overlooking a beach on the Mediterranean Sea. After that transfer to Cairo for over night.

Day 8, Alexandria - Cairo (B)

After breakfast at hotel, free & easy at your own leisure until transfer to airport for your return flight.
