## **Itinerary:**

Meet our local guide at Holiday Inn Singapore Orchard City Center Hotel Lobby and transfer to **Botanic garden**, the 'green lung' of Singapore city centre, and experience the calm and serenity of this 52 hectares garden where you can marvel at the wide variety and colors of Orchids on display.



Next, drive past the city's colonial heritage of **Parliament House**, **Supreme Court**, **City Hall** and **Marina South**. Stop at **Marina Barrage** (Chinese:滨海堤坝), it is a dam in Singapore built across the mouth of the bay, between Marina



East and Marina South. It was officially opened on 1 November 2008. It was Singapore's fifteenth reservoir.

Lunch time; stop at Lau Pa Sat or one of the hawker center for you to taste the variety of local food in Singapore. Lau Pa Sat (or "old market" in the Hokkien dialect) was Singapore's first wet market that dates back over 150 years ago to the time of Sir Stamford Raffles, the founder of Singapore. It was subsequently converted into a famous gourmet paradise and has been gazetted as a national monument since 1973.



After lunch, visit **Little India**, the focal point of Singapore's Indian community. Its spice-scented streets beckon you to a cornucopia of ethnic jewellery, jasmine garlands and silk saris. Next, visit another ethnic site of Singapore, **China** 



**Town**, Singapore's Chinatown evolved around 1821 when the first Chinese junk arrived from Xiamen, Fujian province in China. Chinatown's local name

- Niu Che Shui (Bullock Cart Water) arose from the fact each household at that time had to collect fresh water from the wells in Ann Siang Hill and Spring Street, using bullock-drawn carts.

Our last destination is **Sentosa**, Singapore's premier island resort getaway with multi-faceted appeal, teeming with events all year round. it is a unique blend of leisure and recreational facilities including family attractions, sea sports, golf as well as hotel accommodation and retreats.
