

4 Days Shanghai Tour

Day 1: Singapore – Shanghai (L/D)

Assemble at Changi Airport for your flight to the Largest and Busiest city fo China - Shanghai. Upon arrival met by our local representative and visit the world famous "The Bund" in Shanghai. It was once part of the foreign concessions and out-of-bound to locals. "The Bund" today is Shanghai's financial hub, also known as "Wall Street of the Far East". Next to **Shanghai People Square**, it is a large public square adjacent to Nanjing Road in the Huangpu District of Shanghai, China. People's Square is the site of Shanghai's municipal government headquarter building, and is used as the standard



reference point for measurement of distance in the Shanghai municipality. After lunch continue to visit the Shanghai Wax Museum. And visit the **Oriental Pearl T V Tower**, it is 468 metres high, when viewed across the Huangpu river from the Bund, this impressive Tower along with the Nanpu and Yangpu bridges create a vivid image of "two dragons playing with a pearl". The unique infrastructure of the Tower demonstrates the modern architestural concepts used to add appeal to the structure. The observation deck, revolving restaurant, piano bar and penthouse are spherical in design and constructed to sit at varying heights above ground level thereby enhancing the overall appeal of this major city landmark. After dinner, enjoy the night **Huangpu river tour by Cruise**.

Day 2: Shanghai – Zhujiajiao (Ancient Town) - Shanghai (B/L/D)

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to **Zhujiajiao Ancient Town**. Located in a suburb of Shanghai city, Zhujiajiao is an ancient water town well-known throughout the country, with a history of more than 1700 years. Covering an area of 47 square kilometers, the little fan-shaped town glimmers like a bright pearl in the landscape of lakes and mountains. Afternoon enjoy the Aotelaishi whole sale market.

Day 3: Shanghai (B/L/D)

After breakfast at hotel, visit the **Chenghuang Temple**, it has been through several expansions and the old buildings here have undergone major renovations which have given them a fresh new look. Some new buildings in the styles of the Qing and Ming dynasties have been constructed. There are at least 15 restaurants here that have an ancient, classical ambience. you can taste the various local snacks & famous dishes. Next you visit the **Zhengda Square**, the largest shopping and recreation center in Shanghai. After lunch continue to visit the Shanghai **Huaihai Road, Nanjing Road, and Shanghai Xintiandi**.
