

5 days 4 nights Cambodia Tour

Day 1, Singapore – Siem Reap (D)

Upon arrival at Siem Reap airport, pick up and transfer to hotel for checking in. Free & Easy until 6:00pm, meet your local tour guide at lobby then transfer to local restaurant for dinner.

Day 2, Siem Reap (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel, visit ancient capital of **Angkor Thom** (12th c.), See the **South Gate** with its huge statues depicting the churning of the ocean of milk, the **Royal Enclosure**, **Phimeanakas**, the **Elephants Terrace**, the **Terrace of the Leper King** and **Bayon Temple** (unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara) and the **Baphoun Temple**. Lunch at restaurant; visit the most famous of all the temples on the plain of Angkor: **Angkor Wat**. The temple complex covers 81 hectares and is comparable in size to the Imperial Palace in Beijing. Its distinctive five towers are emblazoned on the Cambodian flag and the 12th century masterpiece is considered by art historians to be the prime example of classical Khmer art and architecture. Angkor Wat's five towers symbolize Meru's five peaks - the enclosed wall represents the mountains at the edge of the world and the surrounding moat, the ocean beyond until **sunset at Bakheng Mountain**. After dinner, transfer back to hotel.



Day 3, Siem Reap (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel, visit to the **Kravan temple**, East-facing brick towers containing unique bas-reliefs of Vishnu and Lakshmi rendered in brick, **Srah Srang**, Originally constructed by the same architect that built Pre Rum temple, **Banteay Kdei**, sprawling, largely unrestored, monastic complex in much the same style as Ta Prohm, Visit to the **Banteay Srey**, one of the smallest temples in the region, Banteay Srey is also one of the most beautiful, showcasing the most exquisite, deep and complex carvings in all Khmer architecture. Lunch at restaurant; visit the floating village of **Chong Khneas**, located 10 kilometers south of Siem Reap. Take a traditional wooden boat for a ride on the **Tonle Sap Lake**, the "Great Lake" of Cambodia, one of the largest in Asia. Dinner at the local restaurant.



Day 4, Siem Reap (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel, visit to **Ta Prohm Temple**, this quiet sprawling monastic complex is only partially cleared of jungle overgrowth. **Thommanon**, small and attractive temple in very good condition, built at the same time as Angkor Wat, **Chau Say Tevoda temple**, displays some well-executed carvings that are in still fair condition, especially those on the eastern gopura, **Neak Pean**, a small island temple located in the middle of the last baray, **Preah Khan**, is a hung, highly explororable monastic complex, **Ta Som**, small, classic Bayon-style, **Pre Rup**, the beautiful carved false doors on upper level, as well as an excellent view of the surrounding countryside and **Mebon temple**, is a large temple-mountain-like ruin, rising three levels and crowded by five towers. Lunch at restaurant; afternoon visit to the countryside around the **Western Baray** area, where you will observe local life there and will be a chance to visit the **Artisans D'Angkor** workshop to see wood and stone carvings or visit the **local markets**. Dinner with **dance show** at restaurant and accommodation at the hotel



Day 5, Siem Reap – Singapore (B)

Breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Siem Reap airport for departure. **End of services.**
