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8 Days Lijiang / Shangri-la / Kunming Tour

Day 1: Singapore – Kunming – Lijiang (B)

Upon arrival, meet our local guide and transfer to hotel for check in. Note: Dinner excluded, please arrange by your own.

Day 2: Lijiang (B)

Full day **Lijing** tour with **Jade Dragon Snow Mountain** with Cable Car, **Glacier Park**, **White Water River**, enjoy a outdoor grand show-Impression of Lijiang. Located between 100 °04'-100 °16'east longitude and 27 °03'-27 °40' north latitude, Jade Dragon Snow Mountain (Yulong Mountain) is the southernmost glacier in the



Northern Hemisphere. Consisting of 13 peaks, among which Shanzidou is the highest one with an altitude of 5,600 meters (18,360 feet), Jade Dragon Snow Mountain stretches a length of 35 kilometers (22 miles) and a width of 20 kilometers (13 miles). Looking from Lijiang Old Town in the south which is 15 kilometers (nine miles) away, the snow-covered and fog-enlaced mountain resembles a jade dragon lying in the clouds, hence, the name Jade Dragon Snow Mountain.

Day 3: Lijiang (B)



Full day Lijiang tour with **The Old Town of Lijiang**, **Black Dragon Pool**, also tour at the **Mu's Mansion** and **Wanggu Pavilion**. The old town of Lijiang has a history going back more than 800 years and was once a confluence for trade along the old tea horse road. The Lijiang old town is famous for its orderly system of waterways and bridges, differing from other ancient Chinese cities in architecture, history and culture. The **Black Dragon** is a famous pond in the scenic Jade Spring Park located at the foot of Elephant Hill, a short walk north of the Old Town of Lijiang in Yunnan province, China. It was built in 1737 during the Qing Dynasty and offers a spectacular view on the region's tallest mountain, Jade Dragon Snow Mountain, over its white marble bridge. The park features several smaller temples and pavilions.

Day 4: Lijiang (B) Full day free & Easy

Day 5: Lijiang – Zhongdian (B)

Transfer to **Shangri-la** after breakfast, Enroute have a view of the **first Bend of Yangtze River**, then visit the **Tiger-leaping Gorge**. On arrival in Shangri-la, firstly tour at **Dukezong Old Town**. **Shangri-La** is a fictional place described in the 1933 novel *Lost Horizon* by British author James Hilton. Shangri-La was described as a mystical, harmonious valley, gently guided from a lamasery, enclosed in the western end of the Kunlun Mountains. Shangri-La has become synonymous with any earthly paradise but particularly a mythical Himalayan utopia — a permanently happy land, isolated from



the outside world. Among the many claims across the world, the cultural representation of Shangri-La is most often cited to be northwestern Yunnan Province, China, where we will visit today.

Day 6: Shangri-La (B

Full day city tour with **Pudacuo National Park** and **Songzanlin Monastery**, built in 1679, the monastery is the largest Tibetan Buddhist monastery in Yunnan province and is sometimes referred to as the *Little Potala Palace*. Located in the capital of Diqing Tibetan Autonomous Prefecture, it is also the most important monastery in southwest China.



Day 7: Zhongdian – Kunming (B)

Today you continue your Shangi-la tour with touring the local farm produce market. After lunch take a flight back to Kunming, met by your local guide transfer to hotel for check in.

Day 8: Kunming – Singapore (B)

Free at your own leisure until transfer to Kunming airport for your return flight back to Singapore.
